In addition to formal coursework, 3-6 units of independent studies (MATRL 596) and 3 units of seminars (MATRL 290) are required.
- 2) The report based on independent studies must be approved by a committee of two faculty members, including the student's advisor. At least one member of the committee must have majority appointment in Materials.
