## Ph.D. (students entering with an M.A. from another institution)

In addition to departmental requirements, candidates for graduate degrees must fulfill University requirements described in the "Graduate Education" section of the UCSB General Catalog.

The Ph.D. program in the Department of Religious Studies comprises a cross-cultural and multidisciplinary approach to the study of religion. The cross-cultural component of the program is concerned with the comparative study of religious traditions from among five cultural areas: Christian, Mediterranean, and European religious traditions; East Asian religious traditions; Jewish, Islamic, and Near Eastern religious traditions; religions of the Americas; and South Asian religious traditions. Students are expected to engage in multidisciplinary approaches to the study of religion and their concomitant methodologies: philosophical, historical, anthropological, and sociological.

Time-to-degree (Track 1): 4 years to advance to candidacy, 7 years to complete the degree Time-to-degree (Track 2): 5 years to advance to candidacy, 8 years to complete the degree
