PREPARATION FOR THE MAJOR

Completion of the sixth quarter (or equivalent) in one foreign language plus the completion of the third quarter (or equivalent) in another foreign language. Students are encouraged to take at least one language outside the Indo-European family; however, the study of two Indo-European languages will satisfy this requirement provided both are not members of either the Germanic, Slavic, or Romance families. Native speakers of languages other than English may petition to count either English or their native language as fulfilling one of the language requirements.

UPPER-DIVISION MAJOR

Before beginning the upper-division major, students are advised to consult the department regarding the scheduling of required courses. Students studying abroad should consult with the Linguistics Department in advance about any Linguistics courses they plan to petition to count toward the major.
