- C. Capstone Experience.....4 _____
 All students must complete Problems in the Study of Religion (Rg St 104) in their Junior or Senior year **or** write a Senior Honors Thesis (Rg St 195) under the guidance of a faculty advisor. The department recommends that all students complete Rg St 104 in their Junior year and that honors students complete Rg St 104 in addition to writing a Senior Honors Thesis.

- Notes:**
- 1) Upper-division courses listed above in more than one area can be applied only to one area.
 - 2) Up to 4 upper-division units from related courses in other departments may be applied to the major by petition.
 - 3) Up to 4 units of Rg St 199 (Independent Study) may apply toward Area A of the upper-division major.

MAJOR REGULATIONS

- PREREQUISITES** Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.
- P/NP GRADING OPTION** Not allowed for any major course (Prep or UD major), including courses applied to the major from other departments.
- SUBSTITUTIONS** In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.
- RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS** At least 20 UD units in major while in residence at UCSB.
- G.P.A. REQUIREMENTS** At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** upper-division major courses **and all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major.
- DOUBLE MAJORS** With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
