DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY – COMMUNICATION – 2021-22

In addition to departmental requirements, candidates for graduate degrees must fulfill University requirements described in the “Graduate Education” section of the UCSB General Catalog.

The Ph.D. in the Department of Communication is awarded to students who demonstrate academic excellence, and the ability to conduct rigorous and meaningful original research. All students must first obtain a thesis-based M.A. degree from UCSB or another accredited institution before working toward the doctorate. In the section below separate notations are made for the two categories of Ph.D. candidates: UCSB M.A. and Outside M.A.

Time-to-degree (M.A./Ph.D.): 4 years to advance; 5 years to complete the Ph.D.

Time-to-degree (Ph.D.): 3 years to advance; 4 years to complete the Ph.D.

Ph.D. COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE M.A./Ph.D. PROGRAM

A total of **74.0** units is required for the Ph.D. degree. Core courses must be completed with a B- or higher. COMM 500, COMM 505, COMM 597, and COMM 599, must be passed satisfactorily. Students are expected to maintain a grade point average of at least 3.25.
