**ADVANCEMENT TO CANDIDACY  
QUALIFYING EXAMINATION AND PAPER RESULTS**

Before advancing to candidacy, students are required to satisfactorily complete a written qualifying exam and a qualifying paper. Both the qualifying exam and the qualifying paper will typically be completed by the end of the third year of study. Students can receive one of the following grades on the qualifying exam and qualifying paper: Pass, Pass at Masters Level, or Fail. Students who do not pass the qualifying exam or qualifying paper will have the chance to rewrite the entire exam / paper or sub-parts of an otherwise acceptable (Pass) exam.

**DISSERTATION**

Students will be expected to enroll in 599-level Dissertation Research and Preparation, as needed, to maintain full-time student status.

Ph.D. candidates must deliver a written dissertation demonstrating the ability to contribute significantly and independently to the major field. The candidate's doctoral committee guides the student in this work and judges the merit of the completed dissertation. Approval of the dissertation by each member of the doctoral committee is required. In addition, candidates will give an oral, public defense of the dissertation. The public defense requirement may be waived with the unanimous consent of the candidate's doctoral committee and the approval of the Graduate Council (per Reg. 355).
