UNITS TO COMPLETE

UPPER-DIVISION MAJOR

40 units are required, distributed as follows:

- A. Social Science and History (8 units)
B. Humanities and Arts (8 units)
C. One upper-division course in Black Studies, Chicana/o Studies, Feminist Studies, or Writing Program courses 109HU or 109SS (4 units)
D. Additional Asian American Studies units from areas A or B, or Writing Program courses 109HU or 109SS (20 units)

Notes:

Students are encouraged to enhance academic writing skills via Writing Program courses 109HU or 109SS and Asian American Studies 108.

Asian American Studies 197 or 199 may be repeated, but only a combined total of 8 units may be applied to this area and the major by petition.

Up to two upper-division courses (8 units) from outside departments may be substituted in this area, by petition, when course content is relevant, for a maximum of 12 units from outside departments toward the major.

MAJOR REGULATIONS

- PREREQUISITES: Check the General Catalog for the prerequisites to all listed courses.
P/NP GRADING OPTION: Not allowed for any major course (Prep or UD major), including courses applied to the major from other departments.
SUBSTITUTIONS: In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.
RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS: At least 20 UD units in major while in residence at UCSB.
G.P.A. REQUIREMENTS: At least 2.0 overall UC average in all upper-division major courses and all courses (Prep and UD) for the major, including courses in excess of minimum requirements.
DOUBLE MAJORS: With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
