**PRE-ECONOMICS MAJOR, B.A. – 2021-2022**

In order to qualify for admission into the Economics major, students must complete Economics 1, 2, and 10A with a UC grade-point average of **2.85** or above. No grade lower than a C in pre-major courses will be accepted. In addition, students must complete PSTAT 109 or 120A and Math 2A-B or 3A-B or 34A-B with a grade of “C” or higher; the grades in these courses will not be used in computing the pre-major GPA but will apply to the overall major GPA.

Acceptance into the pre-major does not guarantee admission to full major status.

**MAJOR REGULATIONS**

- PREREQUISITES**..... Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.
- P/NP GRADING OPTION** ..... Not allowed for any major courses (Prep or UD major), including courses applied to the major from other departments.
- SUBSTITUTIONS**..... In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.
- RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS** ..... At least 20 UD units in major while in residence at UCSB.
- G.P.A. REQUIREMENTS**..... At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** upper-division major courses **and all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major.
- DOUBLE MAJORS** ..... With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
