UPPER-DIVISION MAJOR

B. Any 28 upper-division elective units in Environmental Studies not used in Area A, with no more than one additional course from each cluster in Area A, and with no more than 8 units combined and 4 units each from Environmental Studies 192, 194, 199, and 199RA.

C. Outside Concentration 16

OPTION 1: 16 upper-division units from one department or program. Completion of a double major will satisfy.

OPTION 2: Interdisciplinary Concentration
 16 upper-division units from outside the department of Environmental Studies forming a coherent focus. A plan of study listing the courses to be taken must be submitted by petition and approved by the department chair. Students must discuss their theme and proposed courses with a department advisor prior to beginning this option.

NOTE: All courses (including cross-listed courses) may only apply to one area of the major.

MAJOR REGULATIONS

- PREREQUISITES**..... Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.
- P/NP GRADING OPTION** Env S 190 must be taken P/NP, and up to 4 units of Env S 192 may be taken P/NP for major credit. All other courses, including those applied to the major from other departments must be taken for letter grades.
- SUBSTITUTIONS**..... In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.
- RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS** At least 20 UD units in major while in residence at UCSB.
- G.P.A REQUIREMENTS** At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** UD major courses and **all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major.
- DOUBLE MAJORS** With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to upper-division areas A and/or B and the other upper-division major.
