PLAN II (Exam) - Emphasis in East Asian Languages and Cultural Studies

In addition to departmental requirements, candidates for graduate degrees must fulfill University requirements described in the "Graduate Education" section of the UCSB General Catalog.

Plan II is the Exam track. A total of **72.0 units**; – 64.0 units of coursework in Chinese, Japanese, or East Asian Cultural Studies courses are required for the Plan II M.A. (consult the department for specifics), at least 24.0 units must be graduate-level, in addition to 8.0 units of M.A. preparation for comprehensive exams (course #597). The time-to-degree for the M.A. is two years.

Classical Chinese:			
Students in Chinese studies are required to take 4-8 units of classical Chinese (CHIN 101A-B), depending on whether they have already had the equivalent of 101A or not.			
Classical Japanese:			
Students in Japanese Studies are required to take 4-8 units of classical Japanese, JAPAN 181 and JAPAN 183, depending on whether they have already had the equivalent of JAPAN 181.
