

MASTER OF ARTS – GLOBAL STUDIES: 2022-23 (Plan I – Thesis & Plan II - Project)

*In addition to departmental requirements, candidates for graduate degrees must fulfill University requirements described in the 'Graduate Education' section of the UCSB General Catalog. A total of **60.0 units** are required for the Global M.A. program. All courses should be at the 200-level or above, although exceptions may be granted on a case-by-case basis, to allow up to two courses of upper division undergraduate courses to count as seminar electives. All courses must be passed with a grade of B or better, with the exception of the Contemporary Issues seminar (232A), and GLOBL 596A, 596B, and 598, which may be passed satisfactorily.*
