In addition to departmental requirements, candidates for graduate degrees must fulfill University requirements described in the "Graduate Education" section of the UCSB General Catalog.

M.A. students will follow one of two plans: Plan I (thesis) or Plan II (comprehensive examination). The former time-to-degree is three years from the beginning of graduate study at UCSB of (two years of coursework and one year writing the thesis). The latter time-to-degree requires three years of coursework and a written comprehensive examination. Students continuing for the Ph.D. will normally follow Plan II. Terminal M.A. students will follow Plan I. A total of 60.0 units are required for the M.A. program. These courses must be passed with a grade of B or better.

DIAGNOSTIC EXAMINATIONS

Through diagnostic examinations, all students must demonstrate a sufficient level of competence in Theory and History, or must successfully complete a prescribed course of independent study and be re-tested, unless waived, by the beginning of the second year. Students must also pass a diagnostic exam in Musicianship or successfully complete one or more of the courses specified below.
