PRE-ECONOMICS AND ACCOUNTING MAJOR, B.A. - 2022-2023

In order to qualify for admission into the Economics and Accounting major, students must complete Economics 1, 2, 3A, 3B and 10A with a UC grade-point average of **2.85** or above. <u>No grade lower than a C in pre-major courses</u> <u>will be accepted</u>. In addition, students must complete Economics 5 or PSTAT 120A and Math 2A-B or 3A-B or 34A-B with a grade of "C" or higher; the grades in these courses will <u>not</u> be used in computing the pre-major GPA but will apply to the overall major GPA.

Acceptance into the pre-major does not guarantee admission to full major status.
