**PREPARATION FOR THE MAJOR**

**UNITS TO COMPLETE**

Linguistics 20 ..... 4 \_\_\_\_\_

Completion of the sixth quarter (or equivalent) of a foreign language. Students are encouraged to take a language outside the Indo-European family. Native speakers of languages other than English may petition to count either English or their native language as fulfilling the language requirement.....0-5 \_\_\_\_\_

**UPPER-DIVISION MAJOR**

Before beginning the upper-division major, students are advised to consult the department regarding the scheduling of required courses.

Note: All Language and Speech Technology courses except Linguistics 102 have prerequisites and must be taken in order. Most courses have Linguistics 102 as a prerequisite, so it should be taken as early as possible. One advanced two-course sequence (Linguistics 104 & 105 OR Linguistics 110 & 111 OR Linguistics 110 & 119) must be completed. Because of the prerequisite structure, it must be completed in order.

40 UD units are required, distributed as follows:

- A. Linguistics 102 (Programming for Linguists) ..... 4 \_\_\_\_\_
  - B. Two courses in linguistic structure, chosen from: Linguistics 101, 106, 107, 108, 109 ..... 8 \_\_\_\_\_
  - C. One advanced computational or technical two-course sequence, chosen from:  
(Linguistics 104 & 105) OR (Linguistics 110 & 111) OR (Linguistics 110 & 119)..... 8 \_\_\_\_\_
  - D. Two additional computational or technical courses, chosen from:  
Linguistics 104, 105, 110, 111, 112, 119, 120 ..... 8 \_\_\_\_\_
  - E. Electives: Three additional upper-division courses in Linguistics ..... 12 \_\_\_\_\_  
(up to 4 units of Linguistics 191 or 192 may be applied as upper-division Linguistics  
elective credit toward the major)

**MAJOR REGULATIONS**

- PREREQUISITES**..... Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.
- P/NP GRADING OPTION** ..... Not allowed for major courses (prep or UD major), including courses applied to the major from other departments.
- SUBSTITUTIONS**..... In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.
- G.P.A REQUIREMENTS** ..... At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** upper-division major courses **and all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major.
- DOUBLE MAJORS** ..... With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
