**Notes:**

- Up to 8 units of upper-division electives (Area G) may be taken in music courses at the College of Creative Studies.
- All auditions, including recital auditions, must be reviewed by the Woodwinds/Brass/Percussion Committee and approved by at least two members of the committee. Junior and senior recitals may not be given until the appropriate recital audition has been approved.
- All students enrolled in applied instruction in an orchestral instrument are required to elect orchestra (Mus A42/A142) or wind ensemble (Mus A34/A134), if their participation is needed.

**MAJOR REGULATIONS**

<b>PREREQUISITES</b> .....	Check the <i>General Catalog</i> for the prerequisites to all listed courses.
<b>P/NP GRADING OPTION</b> .....	Up to 8 units of UD CCS music courses may be taken P/NP. All other major units, including those applied to the major from other departments, must be taken for letter grades.
<b>SUBSTITUTIONS</b> .....	In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.
<b>G.P.A REQUIREMENTS</b> .....	At least 2.0 overall UC average in <b>all</b> upper-division major courses <b>and all</b> courses (Prep and UD) for the major.
<b>DOUBLE MAJORS</b> .....	With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
