### Requirements for the minor in MUSIC, 2022-2023

All upper-division courses to be applied to the minor must be completed on a letter-grade basis. This includes both courses offered in Music at UCSB and those offered by other departments and applied to the minor.

#### PREPARATION

#### UNITS TO COMPLETE

Music 11 (which may be considered satisfied by a placement examination) or 5A .....0-4 \_\_\_\_\_

One course from the following: Music 3A, 3B, 3C, 10A, 10B, 10C, 15, 16, 17 .....4 \_\_\_\_\_

Please note:

- Music 3A, 3B, and 3C require consent of instructor.
- A grade of C- or better is required to advance in the Music 3 series.

#### UPPER-DIVISION

18 upper-division units are required in Music ..... 18 \_\_\_\_\_

- *No more than 6 units of performance/composition courses (Music 108, 120-133) may be applied to the minor.*
- *No more than 6 units of ensemble courses A134 through A170AA-ZZ may be applied to the minor.*
- *Upper-division ethnomusicology courses: no prerequisite (Music 17: highly recommended).*
- *Upper-division theory and composition courses require Music 5C or consent of instructor.*
- *All upper-division performance courses, except Music 122, require an audition and consent of instructor.*
- *Upper-division ensembles (music performance laboratories) may require an audition and consent of instructor.*

Substitutions are subject to approval by the Chair of the Department.

Students must consult the *General Catalog* for prerequisites to required courses.

The following conditions must also be met for official recognition of the minor:

- The sponsoring department reports completion of the minor prior to the posting of the degree.
- At least 18 upper-division quarter units are completed for the minor. (Waivers cannot reduce the requirement below this number.)
- The UC grade-point average in ALL applicable upper-division courses is 2.0 or higher.
- No more than 5 upper-division units overlap between this minor and the upper-division portion of the major(s) or other minor(s). If overlap is greater with the major(s), completion of the minor will not be formally recognized; if overlap with other minor(s) is greater, only the first minor reported will be recognized.
