PRE-SOCIOLOGY MAJOR, B.A. – 2022-2023

To qualify for admission into the Sociology major, students must complete the courses in Areas A and B with a UC grade-point average of 2.3 or higher. The courses in Areas C and D will not be included in the pre-major GPA computation but must be taken for a letter grade and will influence the overall major GPA. While completing this required preparation, students will be classified as Pre-Sociology majors. Acceptance into the pre-major does not guarantee admission to full major status. Upon satisfactory completion of the pre-major courses, students must complete a change of major petition, available in the Sociology Undergraduate Office.

Students must complete pre-major courses and achieve the minimum GPA requirements. Courses in Area A and B must be completed with a grade of “C-” or higher

MAJOR REGULATIONS

- PREREQUISITES** Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.
- P/NP GRADING OPTION** Up to 8 units combined of the following courses may be taken P/NP for major credit: Sociology 190A, 191CA, 194, 198, 199, 199RA.
 All other major courses, including those applied to the major from other departments, must be taken for letter grades.
- SUBSTITUTIONS** In the major requirements, permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.
- G.P.A. REQUIREMENTS** At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** upper-division major courses **and all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major.
- DOUBLE MAJORS**..... With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
