A. Nine additional courses (200 or 594 level graduate courses). Three of these must be taken during Year 1 and must be 200-level PSY courses, taken for a letter grade with a B+ average grade (only two 200-level PSY courses are needed in Year 1 if the 'additional statistics course' from Part A is also a 200-level PSY course, taken for a grade). Courses in the second year may be 200 or 594 level graduate courses or, with permission of the student's advisor, upper-division undergraduate courses; can be taken outside the department; and can be taken P/NP or S/U.
